## Artist of the Month

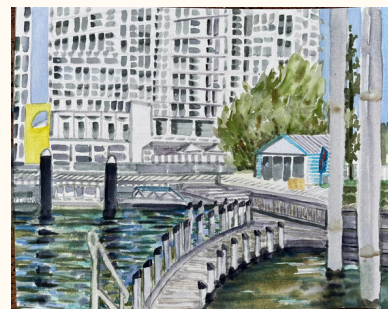
Each month, I spin the "Artists Wheel" to choose our Artist of the Month.

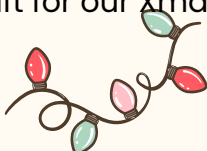
